to make weeding plants easier. It took time, effort and money to get our garden to where we want it to be. It is not finished, as it will always be a "work in progress".




Even now, I am thinking I should take a photo of the beds now, so that in autumn I will be able to remind myself of the necessary removal of some plants to allow the others to flourish better.

Venue for hire




